Executive Summary

A leading U.S. trucking giant, once hit by 140 annual cargo thefts, deployed ENFORCER® Locks and slashed incidents to just 10–15 per year. This 89% drop delivered tens of millions in annual savings, rebuilt trust with high-value clients, and proved robust physical security is a game-changer for large fleets.

Company Background

This national carrier, with thousands of trailers and a large fleet of drivers, serves a wide range of industries requiring high-value freight transportation. As one of America's largest trucking fleets, this company moves billions in high-value cargo annually across the nation. With great scale came great risk, including an average of 140 trailer thefts per year before a recent security overhaul.

Challenges & Issues

In recent years, the company's internal security audit revealed a critical weak point: trailer doors were vulnerable to forced entry. Standard latches and generic padlocks offered little resistance to determined thieves. With rising thefts and escalating cargo values, the financial and operational risks had become unsustainable.

Key concerns included

- Repeated trailer break-ins at distribution centers and drop yards
- Soaring theft-related losses
- · Eroding shipper confidence and reputational damage
- Increased insurance scrutiny

Decision Process & Rationale

The security team was tasked with finding a durable, scalable solution that could be quickly deployed across the national fleet. After extensive consultation with security experts and product testing, the team selected a two-part solution:

ENFORCER® Trailer Door Hasp

Reinforces the latch system and shields the padlock shackle, dramatically improving resistance to cutting and prying.

ABLOY® High-Security Padlock

Corrosion-resistant, pick-proof, and drill-resistant padlocks issued to each driver for uniform protection and ease of use.

Key concerns included

- Proven resistance to physical attacks
- Scalable deployment across the entire trailer fleet
- · Easy integration into existing driver workflows

Implementation

Over a multi-year period, the company systematically upgraded every trailer with the ENFORCER® hasp and provided each driver with an ABLOY® padlock. Deployment was supported by internal training to ensure proper usage and compliance across all regions.



Lessons Learned & Future Plans

This case underscored the value of investing in high-quality, purpose-built physical security. Two key takeaways emerged:

- Tools only work when used consistently. Nearly all remaining thefts occurred due to improper lock usage, highlighting that driver training and compliance were essential.
- Simple upgrades can yield massive ROI. A one-time investment in locks led to multi-year theft reductions and tens of millions in annual savings.

Looking forward, the company is exploring options to integrate lock usage monitoring and real-time tamper alerts to further elevate their cargo security strategy.
